The State Department of Housing and Urban Development through the **Second Kenya Informal Settlements Improvement Project (KISIP2)** now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the **LOT 1 Supply and Delivery of Six (6) Double Cab Pick-up, 4X4, LWB 2700-3200cc Diesel with Rear Fiberglass Pick-up Body** and **LOT 2 One (1) Microbus, Diesel, 14 Seater** to the Project.

Bidding will be conducted through National Competitive procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank’s “Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers” *July 2016 revised November 2017, August 2018 and November 2020* (“Procurement Regulations”), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
